Hi and thank you for borrowing an item from the GRD Gear Library! Here is some useful info for you.

What is the GRD Gear Library?

The GRD Gear Library is a music gear lending service made possible thanks to a partnership between Girls Rock Dublin and Dublin City Libraries.

Through this service, teenagers have access to about 100 items: music instruments, amplifiers, microphones, effect pedals and various accessories, which can be borrowed like a book.

All the gear belongs to Girls Rock Dublin, a volunteer-run, not for profit organisation that aims to grow girls and non-binary youth's self esteem through music creation and performance. Dublin City Libraries house the gear and manage the loans through their system.

The GRD Gear Library is accessible to teenagers of all genders aged 12-17 y.o.

Is using the GRD gear safe?

Yes, it is. The GRD Gear Library complies to safety measures informed by **HSE guidelines**. All returns are quarantined in an isolation room and are stored until they are considered safe, similarly to books. Moreover, to assure a good hygiene level, the gear is also subject to routine cleaning.

What can I do to help keep the GRD gear safe?

We strongly recommend that you **do not try to clean the gear yourself**. In fact, the use of the wrong product and / or the wrong chemicals can damage it. Be assured that the gear made available to be loaned is safe to handle.

To keep a good level of hygiene, we recommend you wash your hands before and after using the gear. That's all.
